Who was Queen Elizabeth I?

Elizabeth I was Queen of England and Ireland from 17th November 1558 to 24th March 1603. She's regarded as one of the greatest monarchs of England. Born 7th September 1533, Elizabeth was the daughter of Henry VIII and his second wife, Anne Boleyn .She was the last Tudor monarch - she never married. During Elizabeth I's reign lots of English explorers searched for new lands and treasures. The explorer Sir Francis Drake was knighted by Elizabeth for services to his country.
