## Key Vocabulary

<b>Abstract art</b>	Relating to or representing art that does not attempt to represent reality, but achieves its effect using shapes, colours, and textures.
<b>Artist</b>	A person who creates paintings or drawings as a profession or hobby.
<b>Geometric shape</b>	Geometric shapes are mathematical shapes, e.g. A triangle or square
<b>Mix</b>	Combine or put together
<b>Primary colours</b>	The three <b>primary colours</b> are typically red, green and blue
<b>Secondary colours</b>	A <b>secondary colour</b> is a colour made by mixing of two primary colours. These are Orange, Green, Violet
<b>Shade</b>	A colour, especially with regard to how light or dark it is
<b>Tertiary colour</b>	Six Tertiary Colours (Ts): Red-Orange, Yellow-Orange, Yellow-Green, Blue-Green, Blue-Violet, Red-Violet, which are formed by mixing a primary with a secondary.
<b>Tint</b>	A colour or a variety of a colour;
